Tina - The Tina Turner Musical - May 6, 2020

The acclaimed London musical success, following the life and times of the legendary *Queen of Rock 'n Roll*, is as good as a musical jukebox gets. It depicts her life from her youth in Nutbush, Tennessee, in an unstable home through her tumultuous relationship with Ike Turner, and comeback as a rock'n roll star in her 40s.

Birthday Candles - May 20, 2020

Debra Messing (*Will and Grace*) returns to the stage as Ernestine Ashworth, who spends her 17th birthday agonizing over her insignificance in the universe. Soon enough, it's her 18th birthday. Even sooner, her 41st. Her 70th. Her 101st. Five generations, dozens of goldfish, an infinity of dreams, one cake baked over a century. What makes a lifetime...into a life? A writer of *freewheeling ambition* (Charles Isherwood, THE NY TIMES), Noah Haidle makes his Broadway debut with this poignant new play (directed by Vivienne Benesch), as fearless in scope as it is tremendous in heart.

West Side Story - June 3, 2020

When four theatrical giants – Jerome Robbins, Leonard Bernstein, Arthur Laurents and Stephen Sondheim – created *West Side Story*, it was immediately hailed as a masterpiece. Producers **Scott Rudin**, **Barry Diller** and **David Geffen** cast as the doomed lovers crossing lines of prejudice and hate, Juilliard discovery Shereen Pimentel, who made her Broadway debut at age 9 in *The Lion King*, as Maria, opposite Isaac Powell, seen in the recent revival of *Once on This Island*, as Tony. They offer a radical, thrilling new interpretation of this iconic work.

Mrs. Doubtfire the Musical - June 17, 2020

Based upon the beloved 1993 Twentieth Century Fox Motion Picture, the show features music and lyrics by Wayne Kirkpatrick and Karey Kirkpatrick (the Tony Award-nominated team behind *Something Rotten!*) and direction by four-time Tony Award winner Jerry Zaks (*Hello, Dolly!* with Bette Midler). When out-of-work actor Daniel Hillard loses custody of his kids in a divorce, he disguises himself as a Scottish nanny to stay in their lives. As he assumes his new role and grows closer to his kids, Mrs. Doubtfire teaches Daniel more than he bargained for about how to be a father. Featuring Broadway favorite and Tony nominee **Rob McClure** (*Chaplin, Honeymoon in Vegas, Beetlejuice*) in the iconic title role!
